

Fishers Figure Skating Club – Membership information for 2009 – 2010

Club membership runs July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010

Membership Categories:

Full Member: \$55 (plus \$250 - \$280 volunteer commitment) *
Professional : \$40
Collegiate : \$20

Ice costs:

Monthly packages will be available for purchase
Club member session walk-on rate: \$12
Non-club member session walk-on rate: \$15

Ice times:

Sunday 3:25 – 4:40 p
Monday: 4:00 – 5:00 p
Friday: 6:00 – 7:00 p

* In response to significantly increased hourly ice costs, the FFSC is instituting a Volunteer Commitment (Full Members only) that will be paid separately from the annual dues.

Volunteer Commitment Options:

- \$250 check that will be held and returned if volunteer hours are completed:
 - Four (4) Aramark concession events worked at Verizon or Victory field during the skating season (July 1, 2009 – June 30, 2010) **and**
 - One (1) club-sponsored event such as Skate-with Santa or the Spring Show
- \$250 check that will be cashed immediately if the member wishes to opt-out of the volunteer hours
- \$35 monthly check (starting in September and ending in April – total of \$280) that would be paid to the club in addition to purchased ice if the member wishes to opt-out of the volunteer hours and doesn't wish to pay the fee all at once. The \$35 monthly fee must be paid every month, regardless of ice time purchased.

Miscellaneous additional information:

Current FFSC memberships expire June 30, 2009. Membership packets will be mailed to your home which will include a membership form, Rules and Conduct Policy, Waiver and Release of Liability form and Parental Consent form, and the Usage Rules and Policies.

If a skater's family works more than four (4) Aramark concession events, 50% of the money brought in by that family from the fifth (5) event and beyond will go to the club and 50% will go to the skater as an ice credit to be used toward monthly package purchases or walk-on fees.

Coaches who are not FFSC Professional members will pay a 10% commission to the club for any lessons given on club ice.

The first date of club ice is Sunday, September 6, 2009 and the last date of club ice is Sunday, April 25, 2010. Club ice will not be available every week; there will be approximately 76 sessions during the skating season.
